Chile Fires

2017, the year that marks the 50th anniversary of the publications of Gabriela Mistral's "Poema de Chile," and it is also the year when, as of January 2017, Chile has suffered the most devastating fires in its history which have destroyed over 500,000 hectares of native forests in many regions of the country and more than 1500 homes.

More than 5000 people lost not only their homes, but also their livelihoods.

During this catastrophic time, the firefighters of Chile, who in their majority are volunteers, fought the flames night and day, most times not being able to see neither the sky, nor the sun, nor the moon or the stars, but only smoke all around.

In February 2017, our the Gabriela Mistral Foundation, Inc. sent a donation of equipment and clothing to the Fire Department in Concepción, that serves 10 communities, valued at over US \$25,000.

Continuing with our mission to help, we work towards being able to send another donation to benefit other fire departments in rural areas who had little, lost it all and now need everything.

For this purpose, on April 11, 2017, the Gabriela Mistral Foundation, Inc. in collaboration with Di Mondo and the North American Chilean Chamber of Commerce hosted "Celebrating Chile —Helping Chile"—a benefit concert. The concert was performed by "Music for Chile," under the direction of Ramón Catalán, director and composer.

GABRIELA MISTRAL FOUNDATION – March 24, 2017

The 2017 Annual Women's Day Conference at Seton Hall University on the topic of "Women and Gender—Now, Then, Tomorrow" included a special presentation about Gabriela Mistral and the book "From Chile to the World," published by the Gabriela Mistral Foundation. Taking its cue from tremendous local, national, and international changes in the past year, this year's conference addresses the theme of "Now-Then-Tomorrow." We seek papers that engage critically with women and gender issues in the world today, in the distant or recent past, and in possible or probable developments or challenges in the future. The organizers are looking to offer a collection of exciting sessions that reflects the dynamic, productive diversity of perspectives and approaches characterizing the current discussion about these subjects.

The conference's primary goal is consistent with the ideals of a liberal arts institution such as those articulated by Cardinal Newman in *The Idea of a University*: to provide an interface between the academic and the experiential in order to enrich lived life. Collaboration “Fixed Stars”—a documentary: Life & Work of Oscar Hahn

GABRIELA MISTRAL FOUNDATION – May 10, 2017

The Directorate of Cultural Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Chile in collaboration with the Embassy of Chile US and the Gabriela Mistral Foundation present the US Premiere Screenings of “Fixed Stars” a documentary film of Orlando Torres-Osorio on the Life & Work of Oscar Hahn in the United States. Special events were held in: Cedar Rapids, Iowa; Iowa City, Iowa; Chicago, Illinois; Washington DC and New York City. The film’s title is taken from one of Hahn’s poems. In “Estrellas Fijas,” Osorio draws passages of Hahn’s life by interviewing his friends in the United States and in Chile. The documentary follows the poet’s life—from his birth in the northern city of Iquique, through his 30 years as Professor of Hispanic Literature at the University of Iowa. “Estrellas Fijas” was filmed in the Chilean cities of Iquique, Rancagua and Santiago, as well as in Iowa City. In September 2016, the film was awarded “Best International Documentary” at the International Jakarta Film Festival for Documentaries and Short Films held in Indonesia.

After seeing the documentary, Oscar Hahn remarked: “I find the work done by Orlando Torres-Osorio admirable, because I am a person who has been everywhere: Chile, and abroad, and he went to all these places to interview people who know me or that have known me at one point in my life is remarkable. To then be able to create a coherent film with the information gathered is quite another thing. He did a good job, and to me, that is a sign of a good director.” “My interest was to present the lyric universe of Oscar Hahn to all kind of viewers, because his poems have a cinematographic and narrative quality that makes them shine like short stories,” said Torres-Osorio “Some of them form a link to our most unconscious thoughts in a very direct way which relates very well to all kind of readers.”

“Estrellas Fijas” had its world premiere in November 2016 at the Heidelberg Center Latinoamérica in Santiago. It has since been presented in various cities in Chile, including Hahn’s native city of Iquique. “Estrellas Fijas” was recently awarded a grant by the Directorate of Cultural Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Chile, allowing Torres-Osorio to exhibit his work in Cedar Rapids, Iowa City, Chicago, Washington DC and New York in collaboration with the Embassy of Chile; the Gabriela Mistral Foundation, Inc. and Coe College.

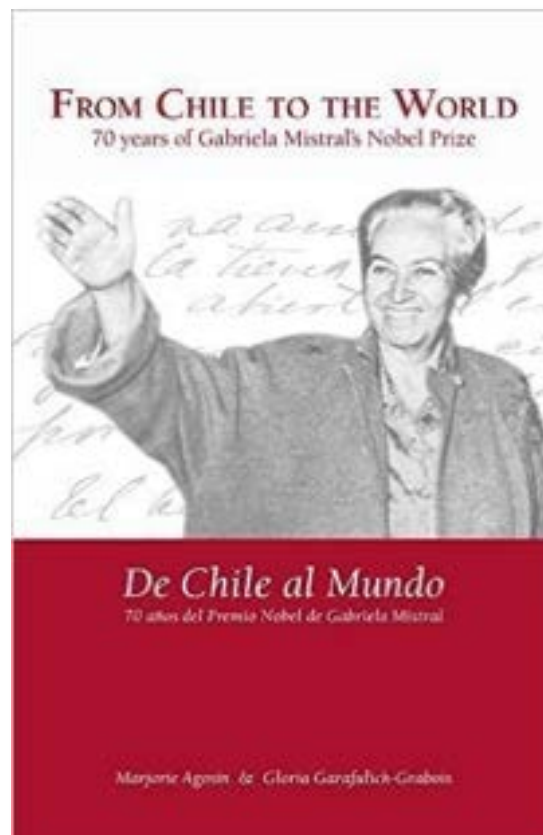

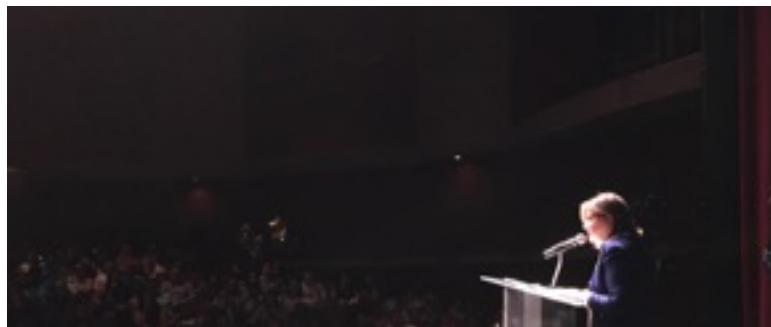

Pero esto cambia incluso dentro de Estados Unidos, dependiendo de la industria con la que te vincules y la zona del país. Y, al mismo tiempo, la globalización hace que cada vez todos nos parecemos más.

¿El colegio Gabriela Mistral Campus en Buenos Aires, que cumple un año, es uno de los logros más significativos de la fundación que usted dirige? ¿Qué fue lo más difícil al sacar adelante este proyecto? Al comienzo me faltaron con gente que no sabía bien quién era Gabriela Mistral ni la importancia que tenemos las Américas, en la diplomacia, en la educación. Logrélo con el tiempo. Pero lo más importante, al pensar un proyecto, no es solo idearlo e implementarlo, sino tener claro cómo hacerlo sostenible en el tiempo. El proyecto debe ser realista en cuanto a cómo se hace y también en qué es lo que puede entregar.

¿Conseguir fondos es un desafío para toda fundación. ¿Cuál le sirve de estrategia? Eventos, campañas, recibimos donaciones. En 2015 recibimos una edición bilingüe del libro “Desde Chile al mundo: 70 años del Premio Nobel de Gabriela Mistral”, en el que trabajamos el honorario, cupos varias apoyos la fundación. Pero lo más importante es un trabajo bien hecho. Cuando tienes eso, la gente se entusiasma y decide apoyar.

¿Qué desafíos ha enfrentado como directora de entidades culturales y de acción social? En cualquier cargo hay desafíos. En mi caso, uno de los más grandes es querer hacer más cosas que hay mucha necesidad. Para esto estar en los eventos, ser partícipe del trabajo en equipo: los logros son de todos.

¿Qué consejo le daría a quienes quieren iniciar una fundación? Que hagan trabajo voluntario por un tiempo, para entender bien cómo funciona una fundación, además de ver si uno realmente se puede comprometer con un proyecto de este tipo. Hacer una fundación es un trabajo a largo plazo, y para muchas personas, es un desafío lograr ser consistentes.

¿Cómo ha aprendido a delegar y cómo busca gente que le de la confianza para ello?

Hay que hacer la tarea de buscar a la persona adecuada y tomar el tiempo que uno requiere. Si bien no hay una receta, me parece importante tener fe en que las decisiones que se toman son correctas. En esto los algoritmos y cálculos matemáticos funcionan solo hasta cierto punto, hay que seguir la intuición. Y también ser flexible, tener un plan B, porque así la vida todo se va permitiendo ir ajustando.

¿Qué frase, acción o texto de Gabriela Mistral le inspirado su trabajo? Todo es obvia inspiración. Pero recuerdo especialmente una carta que escribió en 1948. Concluye en esa carta nació la Unión. En un párrafo dice: “Muchas de las cosas que hemos merecido en Suram espera. El niño no. Él está haciendo ahora mismo sus besos, criándose su sangre y empujando sus sentidos. A él no se le puede responder mañana. Él se llama ahora”.
