It is with great honor that the New York City Department of Education headed by Chancellor Carmen Farina announces the renaming of the Corona Arts and Science Academy (CASA). It will be renamed this fall the Corona Arts and Science Academy (CASA) at the Gabriela Mistral Campus. This campus is located at 45-10 94<sup>th</sup> Street, Queens, NY 11373.

Since you and members of the Gabriela Mistral Foundation first approached us in January 2015, the New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE) has been ardously working to select a suitable NYC public school on which to bestow the honor of having their school named after Gabriela Mistral. She was a woman whose legacy included being an educator, poet, humanitarian, diplomat, the first Latin American to win the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1945 and an advocate for the rights of children, women and the poor.

Naming a school follows a protocol in which many constituencies must consider and approve the request. The school was selected after much consideration from many constituencies including the Division of English Language Learners (DELLSS); Superintendent of District 24, Madelene Chan; Principal of CASA, Beth Hertz, CASA's Leadership Team, CASA's Parent Teacher Association and the Community District Council for District 24; all of which unanimously voted to be granted this special distinction. The Division of English Language Learners and Student Support, (DELLSS) spearheaded this request and took on the responsibility to embark in identifying, supporting and guiding the district and school.


The NYC DOE would like to hold a ceremony to inaugurate the naming of CASA at the Gabriela Mistral Campus. We understand that Chilean President, Michelle Bachelet, will be attending the 2016 United Nations General Counsel the week of September 19th. We are respectfully requesting that President Bachelet be present at the ceremony, if time permits on her calendar.

This ceremony will mark a historical event for the New York City Department of Education where a school campus is named after an educator from Chile. We are looking forward to inviting the president of Chile and dignitaries from the Chilean Embassy. Please let us know at your earliest convenience of a tentative date when we can hold this ceremony.








## Book Donation - Hospital Sotero del Rio


