# 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the announcement of Gabriela Mistral's Nobel Prize November 15



On a day like today, while living in Petropolis, Brazil, and while listening to the radio, *Gabriela Mistral* learned that she had been awarded the *Nobel Prize in Literature*.

She recalls this moment as follows:

*"I was in Petropolis, alone in my room, listening to the news of Palestine. After a brief pause, the radio station made the announcement that stunned me, and that I did not expect. I fell on my knees in front of the crucifix that was always with me, and in a sea of tears I prayed: "Jesus Christ, make this, your humble daughter worthy of such high honor."\**

*Gabriela Mistral, November 15, 1945*



The next day, she received the formal notification by telegram from the Swedish Academy. The text of the telegram reads as follows:

*"16 Nov. 1945*

*Mrs. Gabriela Mistral, the Swedish Academy has awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature to you, Madam, and invites you to the Nobel Prize celebration in Stockholm on December 10. We await your acceptance by telegram to Secretary Osterling of the Academy."*

Original text of the telegram in French:  
*Mme. Gabriela Mistral l' académie suédoise a décerne le prix nobel littéraire a vous madame, et vous invite a la fête nobel a Stockholm le 10 décembre en attendant votre acceptation télégraphique au secrétaire de l'académie.*




